

Welcome to East Ham Cemetery



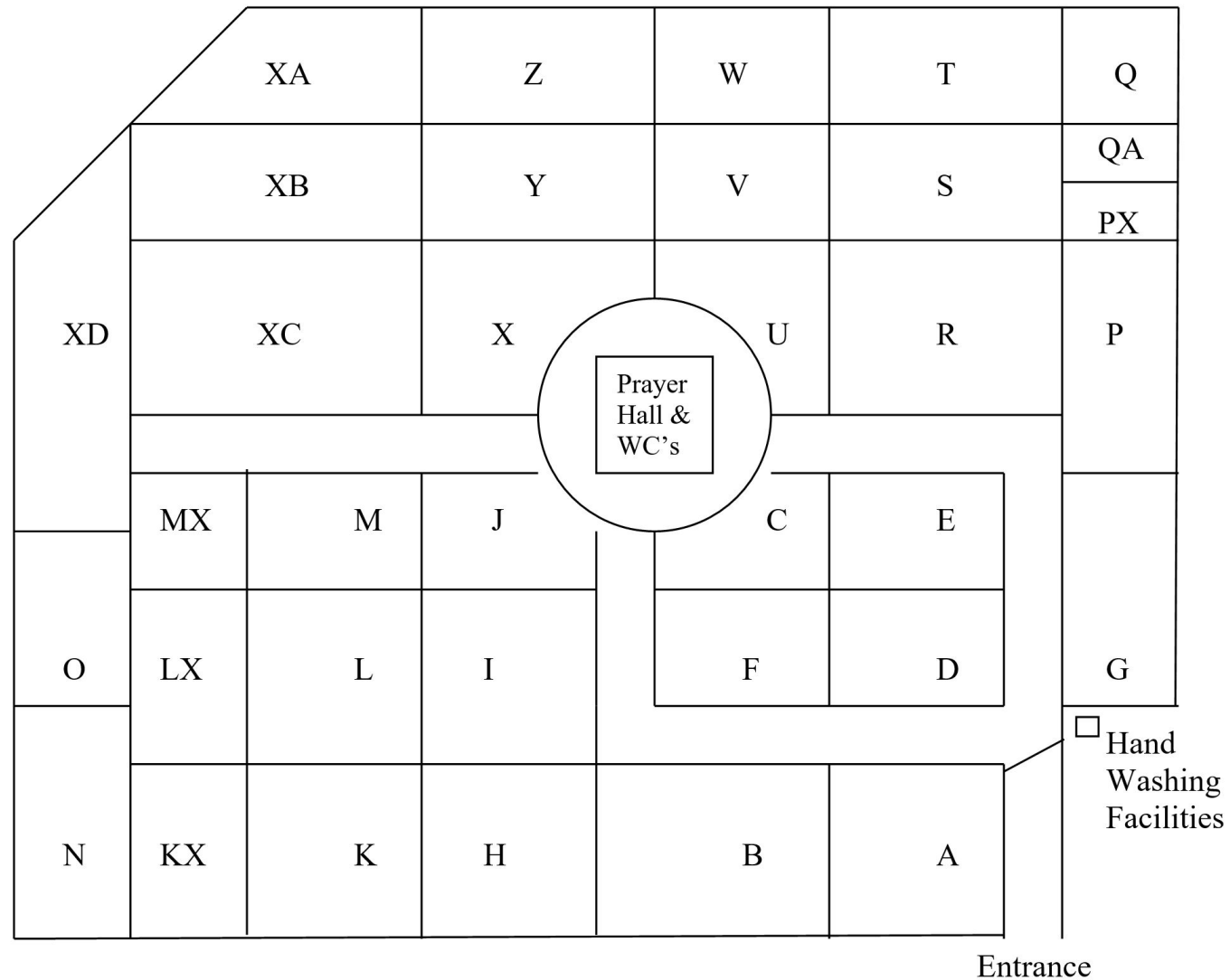
Visiting the grave of a departed relative, particularly a parent, is an act of respect which should be carried out with reverence and decorum.

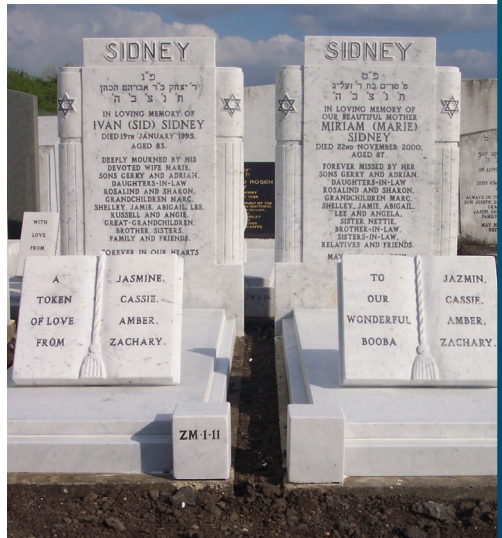
